Covid-19 guidelines at the time of the Festival must be followed to ensure that the event is Covid safe.

The event will be held in and around St Mary's Church Old Basing & Lychpit. We regret there is no parking on site, although there is temporary unloading space. There is disabled parking on application to the Church Wardens.

The booking fee of a minimum of £7.50 secures your allocated display space. Displays of any height must be free standing.

All exhibitors will be acknowledged in the programme, display will be allocated a number.

Setting up time **Saturday June 26th 9.00 -10.45**

Small prize will be awarded for the Display voted Favourite. Voting will end at 3.30 pm on 27th June.

The displays can be dismantled from 4pm 27th June until 4th July.

Any displays not collected by then will be disposed of or recycled.

All packing material must be taken away, there is no storage space and it is your responsibility to ensure your space is left clear at the close of 4th July. There is no need to 'man' your display during the Festival, although you are welcome to do so. We cannot take responsibility for valuable ornaments and decorations.
